INVESTATLANTA

Eligibility



A for-profit business is eligible for the ATLinBusiness program if it meets all of the following:

- Holds a 2022 City of Atlanta business license;
- Can attest (via an affidavit) to having a financial hardship such as declines in revenues or impacts of periods of business closure as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- Had fewer than 250 employees as of December 31, 2021. Business must provide either Q4 2021 Form 941 or detailed payroll journals reflecting number of employees.

*if the business is a Sole Proprietorship, then the business owner may provide a signed letter stating that they have no employees

A non-profit business is eligible for the ATLinBusiness Program if it meets all of the following:

- Holds a 2022 City of Atlanta business license or Letter of Good Standing;
- Can provide a copy of their IRS Determination Letter;
- Can attest (via an affidavit) to having a financial hardship such as declines in revenues or impacts of periods of business closure as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- Had fewer than 250 employees as of December 31, 2021. Non-profit must provide either Q4 2021 Form 941 or detailed payroll journals reflecting number of employees.
